Protects original text or art.

Protects new technology. e.g. an easy-pour mechanism or honey blending method.

Design

Protects the aesthetic (non-functional) aspects of the container.

Trade Mark

Protects the brand name and/or logo of the product and the manufacturer.

Other forms of protection include:

Geographical Indication

Protects products closely associated with specific places or regions, e.g. Waterford Blaa, Parmigiano Reggiano.

Trade Secret

Keeping a process, method or the contents of a product secret, e.g. special recipes or industrial processes.
