LOEL Amendment - Terms for Live Streaming

These terms ("the Additional Agreement") apply in addition (and as amendment) to the standard LOEL terms ("the LOEL Agreement") in circumstances where the Licensee is live streaming as part of a religious service, fitness class, dance or other educational class to members of the public in the Republic of Ireland via the following platforms:

- Videos hosted on their own website
- FaceTime
- Google hangouts
- Microsoft Teams
- Skype
- WhatsApp
- Zoom

Unless stated otherwise defined terms used in this Additional Agreement shall have the meaning given in the LOEL Agreement.

In such circumstances:

1. Any synchronisation licences required shall be included within the terms of the LOEL Agreement, notwithstanding clause 3.3 of the LOEL Agreement, though such synchronisation licences shall solely cover the exploitation specifically set out in this amendment to this Additional Agreement.
2. For the avoidance of doubt, even though the LOEL Agreement covers activities other than live streaming, the synchronisation rights granted under this Additional Agreement only cover live streaming and not any other form of exploitation, such as on-demand or interactive streaming or downloading. Content must not be recorded in any form, either by the Licensee or the User.
3. The Licensee shall pay the additional synchronisation licence fees over and above the Royalty Fees for the LOEL.
4. For the avoidance of doubt, the Licensed Services concerned must not be made available outside of the Republic of Ireland.
5. The Licensed Services concerned must not be made available to more than 60 Users concurrently.
6. The Licensee shall provide to the Licensors details of the Musical Works live streamed in the format outlined in appendix 2 to be provided at the end of each calendar month by email to onlinelicensing@imro.ie.
7. Additional rights will be added to your standard LOEL licence fee on a pro rata basis as outlined in appendix 1.
8. These rights are granted until 30th June 2021 only and on an entirely non-precedential basis.
